Essay Contest Rules:

- No application is required.
- Entrant must be a current member of the Legal Marketing Association, in the Chicago Chapter or as a member-at-large in one of the LMA Chicago City Groups: Indianapolis, Milwaukee, or Detroit.
- Essay must be solely the work of the entrant.
- Essay may be of any length.
- Essay must be submitted in Word or PDF format via email to jmwinterlex@aol.com. Essay must be emailed no later than Tuesday, June 30, 2009, at 11:59 PM CT.
- Decisions of the judges are final.
- Members of the LMA Chicago Board of Directors and of the 2009 LMA Midwest Conference Committee are not eligible for this contest.
- All entries become the property of the Legal Marketing Association and may be used for publicity or advertising purposes.
- Winners and participants will be notified by Wednesday, July 8, 2009.
